GENERAL OFFICER CANDIDATE DECLARATION FORM

CofC General Bylaws, Article VII, Section 4: Those wishing to run for a General Office must have served at least one full term as a Division Officer, preferably as a Division President, or have served as a Chapter President in Chapters where there are no Divisions. To be eligible for the office of President General, a member of a Division must have served or be in the process of serving one full term on the General Executive Committee, and members from Chapters where there are no Divisions must have served two full terms or be in the process of serving a second full term on the General Executive Committee.

All nominees shall be a member in good standing of the Children of the Confederacy. Dues must be current for both General and Division. Division Director verifies that the candidate meets the above qualifications and that dues are current. Candidates for General office must attend the General Convention.
